25 YEARS OF COUNSELLING

HIV Counselling has changed dramatically!

- **1990's**: Terminal Illness (→ more compassion)
- Now: Chronic Condition

Stigma remains one of the biggest issues in HIV Counselling

WHAT IS STIGMA?

- Negative stereotype
- "A mark of disgrace or reproach"
- PLWHIV report that how others judge them is one of their greatest barriers to a complete and satisfying life.

THE ENORMITY OF STIGMA

- 17% of PLWHIV suicidal vs. 4% of general population
- Personal relationships:
 - 2/3 fear rejection
 - 1/3 have experienced rejection
- 20% have experienced stigma from immediate family
- 18% have experienced stigma from health professionals
 - → judgemental attitudes
 - → inadvertent disclosure

EXTERNAL AND INTERNAL STIGMA

External:

- Friends, family, colleagues, doctors, employers, etc.
- Internal: (Self Imposed)
 - Self judgment, Shame, Fear, Disgust, Hopelessness, Worthlessness
 - Can result in depression, social withdrawal, overcompensation, not accessing medical treatment

DISCLOSURE


- Intimate relationship with Stigma
 - No Stigma => disclosure not such a big deal
- Who/When/How to share HIV status
- Pre-HAART: Disclosure was involuntary
- Now: Disclosure is discretionary
- Objective: Find one's own unique position on the 'Disclosure Scale'



REAL LIFE EXAMPLES OF STIGMA

- Relationships breaking up / Being disowned by families
- "My mother won't hug or kiss me anymore."
- Jobs being lost / not being offered
- Services being denied
- Friends disappearing
- Verbal and physical and online abuse
- Being run out of communities / Being blanked at the local pub
- Having to abandon studies
- Continuing to breastfeed in public
- Engaging in high-risk behaviours (self and others)
- "Take a Valium and go home and whatever you do don't tell your mother"




